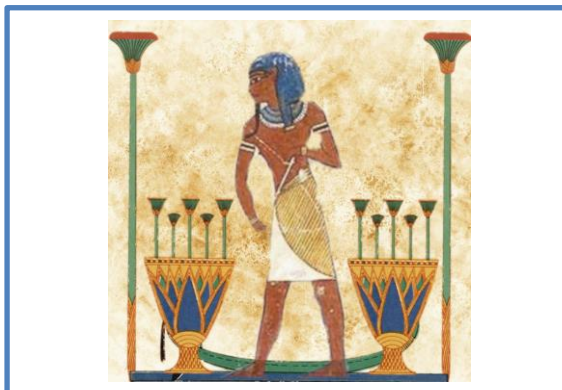

Add and subtract two 2-digit numbers crossing the tens boundary

Calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division within the multiplication tables and write them using the multiplication (\times), division (\div) and equals ($=$) signs
Tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour

Year 3

Add and subtract a three digit number and a two digit number crossing the tens boundary

Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables

Write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables that they know

Read the time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute
