## Year 3

Prefixes e.g. un-, re-

Suffixes -tion, -ly

Use of the forms a or an when next word starts with a consonant or a vowel

Word families based on common words showing how words are related in form and meaning

Expressing time, place and cause using adverbs e.g. (then, next, soon, therefore)

Expressing time, place and cause using prepositions e.g. (before, after, during, in, because of)

Introduction to paragraphs as a way to group related material

Headings and sub-headings to aid presentation

Inverted commas to punctuate direct speech

## Year 4

Verb inflections (we were instead of we was)

Suffixes -tion, -sion, -ly

Noun phrases expanded by the addition of modifying adjectives, nouns and prepositions

Fronted adverbials

Nouns or pronouns to aid cohesion and avoid repetition

Paragraphs to organise ideas around a theme

Apostrophes for plural possession

Inverted commas and other punctuation to indicate direct speech

Use commas after fronted adverbials



### Year 3

### Year 4

Recognise common equivalent fractions; count up and down in hundredths; add and subtract fractions with the same denominator; recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths;

recognise and write decimal equivalents to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{3}{4}$

Round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number
