
Reading



In phonics, we will be reviewing the sounds taught so far. To best support us in teaching your child how to read we ask that you read the decodable text provided by the school at least 4 times across the week. Spending just 5 or 10 minutes a day reading with your child will **hugely** support them in their journey to becoming an independent reader. Please do record these sessions in your child's reading record so we can reward their efforts.

Maths

The children will be investigating consecutive whole numbers, discovering how each whole number's value goes up by one. We will also be mixing up the order of numbers and look at how the value may not go up by one.
