The children will also be collecting acorns at school and learning about life cycles of trees and plants.

Phonics

We will be consolidating all our learning and practising using the letters and sounds the children have learnt so far.

We will be encouraging the children to make, read and write 3 letter words from those sounds.

Please find attached flashcards of the letters the children have learnt so far. Please cut them out and make 3 letter words at home for your child to practise reading.

Maths

This week, the children will build on their subitising skills (instant recognition of a quantity without counting). As well as looking at different amounts of objects, we will asking the children to say the number of sounds they hear, such as claps or drum beats without the need to count.

The children will also be encouraged to represent quantities by using the number of fingers on one hand, then two hands. The children will be the ability to show different amounts all at once. For example, we will ask "Can you show me 4 on your fingers?".
