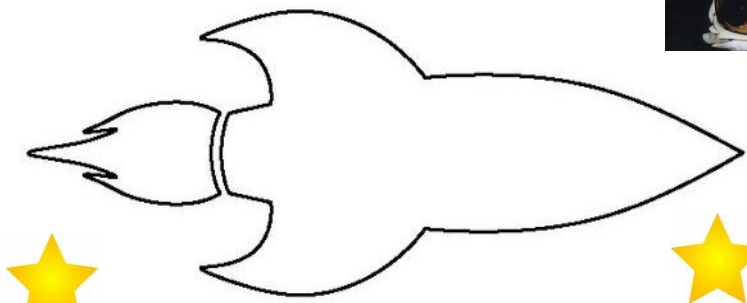
From: United States of America
