In maths, we will be practising our addition skills and comparing groups to see which contain more and which have less. We will learn about estimating quantities and making sensible guesses.



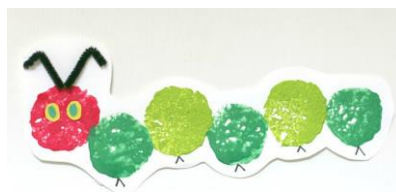
