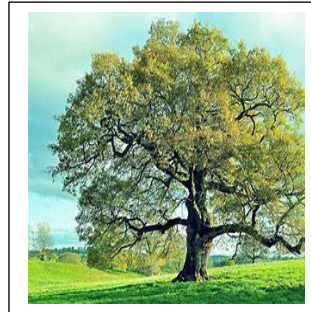
Vehicle Text - A story like the Wind
