## Poor Home Life

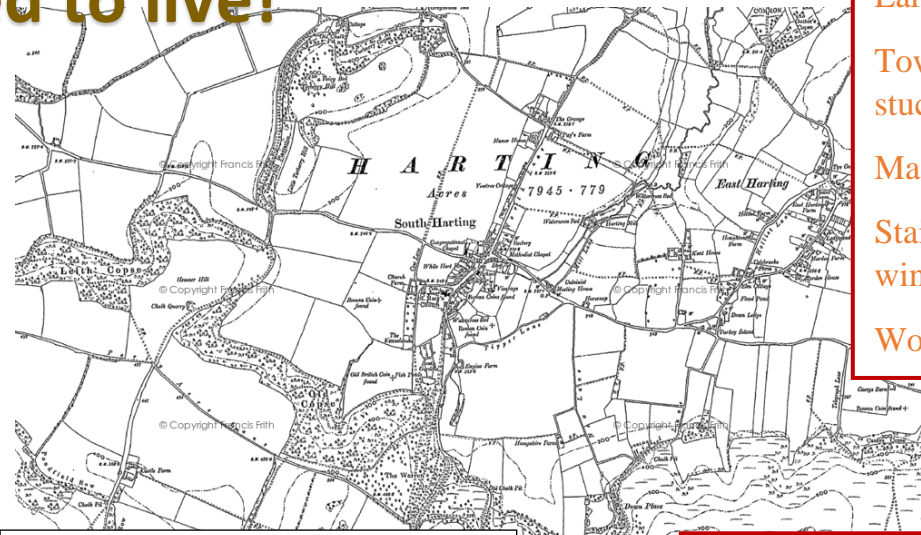
- Small houses- 1/2 rooms
