• I had the most amazing time away and saw the coolest things!


 Sorry I took one of your bus tickets but I was so excited to see all the Edinburgh Landmarks!!

I then boarded the plane, I had the window seat!!




Up high in the sky!!




On Saturday I woke up bright and early and did some exploring!!

I then got on the bus and the lovely bus lady took my ticket! I even had a picture with her, she was so friendly!









Can you guess where I went first?















I then went to explore a bustling, lively street! Can you remember what tthis street was called?





Sadly, there were no big events happening on the street like crowds of people playing on bag pipes, but I did see


this funny man!

On Sunday I did some more exploring.


This is Princes Street. Do you know what this mode of transport is called?
