TERRACYCLE at Harting

Harting CAN (Eco) group has approached us to see if we would be open to running a TERRACYCLE collection scheme. The company arranges the recycling of a wide variety of plastic packaging that cannot currently be put into your burgundy recycling bin, e.g. instead of biscuit/snack wrappers or cheese packaging going into landfill via your



black bin, they could eventually become garden furniture, watering cans, storage containers, floor tiles etc.

Being a collection point for the community will be good for the children and good for the environment. The school would build up Terracycle "points" which can be converted to cash for school funds.

PLASTIC MILK BOTTLE TOPS

These cannot go into your burgundy recycling bin but can be recycled by specialists. St Paul's Church, Chichester collect **MILK** bottle tops of all colours in aid of The Chestnut Tree Hospice. The new Harting collection point is at **31 SOUTH ACRE**. Please ensure they are **clean & dry**, then tip them into the box provided. They will be delivered to Chichester regularly to keep them out of landfill and to help this worthy cause.
